Documents required for a foreign student who stays at the territory of the Russian Federation

- 1. Passport and passport translation (in the absence of a page in Russian);
- 2. Migration card;
- 3. Notification of migration registration (registration at the place of **residence**);
- 4. Visa (for visa countries):
- 5. Medical insurance policy (Compulsory Health Insurance* or Optional Medical Insurance), issued on the territory of the Russian Federation**;
- 6. Certificate of the medical examination:
- chest fluorography;
- vaccination certificate;
- certificate of the absence of infectious diseases that are dangerous to others (AIDS, HIV, leprosy (Hansen's disease), tuberculosis, sexually transmitted diseases (syphilis, chlamydial lymphogranuloma (venereal) chancroid);
- certificate of passing the compulsory preliminary medical examination (examination in the form 086-y) for applicants for the specialty "General Medicine" Training Programme "directions Pedagogical education", "Pedagogical education (with two training profiles)", "Psychological and pedagogical education" "Special (defectology) education "and others. (Appendix 2 to the Admission Regulations).

^{** &}quot;A foreign citizen or a stateless person is not allowed to enter Russia unless they have submitted a health insurance policy valid in the Russian Federation – prior to its submission, except for (on the basis of reciprocity) employees of diplomatic missions and consular offices of foreign states, members of international organizations, their family members. (Clause 5, Article 27 of the Federal Law No. 114 dated August 15, 1996 "On the Russian Federation Exit and Entry Procedure").
